

Wondrous Winter officially kicked off on Friday, Nov. 28, with the Singing With Santa caroling procession on Main and holiday tree lighting. The giant 100-ft. spruce at the corner of Main and 12th St. has become a landmark during Durango's holiday season, and its lighting marked the beginning of the traditional holiday season. 
