#### 2017 Highlights

- We accepted our 29th class into Leadership La Plata with members from Durango, Bayfield, Hesperus and rural La Plata County
- Financial support and scholarships continue to be provided to ensure that all students can participate
- The class of 2017-2018 is well underway and experienced another successful retreat with Phil Bryson and crew at Vallecito. Phil continues to support LLP with his personal ropes courses and social styles trainings. - For the third year, we contracted with a Leadership Coordinator who is tasked with attending all program days, Curriculum Committee Meetings, coordinating each two hour leadership training during program days and reporting progress monthly to the Steering Committee. This position has helped maintain consistency and learning during and between program days. In 2017, Tracy Cornutt (Class of '11-12) served in this role.
- Tracy attended the Association of Leadership Programs Conference to learn from, and network with, leadership programs from around the country as we continue to improve LLP.
- We've matched 28 alumni as mentors with upcoming community leaders through our LLP/YPOD mentorship program

#### Alumni Programs and Events Update

The Alumni Committee is excited and committed to creating interesting and fun events and programs to keep you engaged and connected with LLP and offer you exclusive community opportunities.

In the past couple of years, we've hosted many successful events; a tour of Fort Lewis College's new GPE Hall (Geology, Physics, Engineering) with a talk by President Dene Thomas had over 60 alumni

and guests in attendance and the privilege of being the first group to see the new telescope up close; former City Planner, Greg Hoch, packed the house with a Durango history lesson at the Powerhouse with great food provided by Steamworks (Thank you, Kris Oyler, class of '02-03); a small business talk at Earth Girls with Kirsten Gum was inspirational along with fresh, tasty food and drinks; Durango City Manager Ron LeBlanc's leadership and civic engagement talk at the Underground, catered by the Irish Embassy, was a successful evening full of learning.
