# Durango La Plata County Airport Update

- Director of Aviation Tony Vicari told La Plata County Commissioners the Durango La Plata County airport is seeing steady growth and recovery. There was historic traffic in June, July and August, leading to the busiest summer of all time. The traffic at the airport far outweighs the recovery nationwide.
- Frontier Airlines has extended their seasonal service to Denver International Airport through at least Jan. 3, 2022. Last spring, Frontier announced seasonal service to Denver would occur four times per week through the summer. In late summer, they extended the reservation window for two flights per week between DRO and Denver through November 1. Frontier recently confirmed this service will continue through the New Year.
- Delta Air Lines has announced daily nonstop flights between Salt Lake City International Airport and Durango-La Plata County Airport will be cancelled, effective Nov. 1, 2021. The Delta Connection service was operated by SkyWest Airlines and has operated twice daily seven days per week since May 26. Travelers with existing reservations on Delta Air Lines at DRO for November 1 or after can <u>cancel online</u> or call 1-800-221-1212 for help with refunds or rebooking.

#### **Unemployment Rate Update**

- La Plata County unemployment rate was 4.8% in August, down from 5.2% in July.
- San Juan County was 3.6% in August, slightly down from 3.7% in July.
- Archuleta County was 4.4% in August, down from 4.7% in July.

#### **November Election**

- 8 October- First day mail ballots may be sent to voters
- 12 October- Last day to submit an application to register to vote through a voter registration drive for the Coordinated Election.
- 25 October- Last day to submit an application to register to vote through the mail, a voter registration agency, a local driver's license examination facility, or online to receive a mail ballot for the Coordinated Election.
- 2 November- Coordinated Election (Polls open 7:00am to 7:00pm. First Tuesday in November)

#### **November Ballot Questions**

- Amendment 78: The initiative would transfer the power to appropriate custodial funds (state revenue not generated through taxes) from the state treasurer to the state legislature.
- **Proposition 119:** The proposition would create the Learning Enrichment and Academic Progress Program (LEAP). The measure would increase the marijuana retail sales tax incrementally from 15% to 20% to partially fund the program.
- **Proposition 120:** The proposition would lower the property tax assessment rate for multi-family residential homes to 6.5% from 6.8% and lower the assessment rate for lodging properties to 26.4% from 29%.
  - La Plata County adopted a resolution opposing Proposition 120.
